Note 3 Your Boats

Please enter details of all craft you wish to sail at the club.

Note 4 Membership Type

Please indicate the membership type you require (see Subscriptions for details).

Each craft will require a sailing licence.

Any road trailers not stored under your boat will require a trailer licence.

Individual members with more than one boat may request additional free of charge sailing licences if they confirm in writing that they will not have more than one craft on the water at any time. Please complete the "Additional Free Sailing Licence Declaration".

Windsurfers need only purchase sailing licences for the maximum number of boards that they will have on the water at any one time. Please state how many you require.

Note 5 Duty Members

Every member of DSC is required to assist with the running of the club by doing sailing duties.

There are four types of duties:

Race Officer/Officer of the Day (RO/OOD) – you are responsible for the running of races and sailing for the day, supported by:

Safety Boat Officer (SBO) – you must hold an RYA Powerboat 2 qualification or greater.

Assistant Safety Boat Officer (ASBO) – you must be physically fit and able to assist the SBO – no qualifications required.

Galley Officer – you are responsible for providing refreshments in the clubhouse.

Details of each duty are available in the club handbook. Training is available.

Please provide an email address for each nominated duty member.

Please confirm any relevant training qualifications.

Please confirm if you wish to be included in our list of members who are willing to cover another member's duty for a fee. Some members are willing to pay someone else to do their duty. This is a private arrangement between members, but we can facilitate such swaps.

You will be able to select your duties on-line once your renewal has been processed on a "first come – first served" basis. You will receive a notification email from www.dutyman.biz when available.

A Sunday or Bank Holiday duty is worth 2 points. A Saturday afternoon, or Wednesday evening is worth 1 point.

Individual members are required to do a minimum of 3 points in one season. Family member are required to do a minimum of 6 points between them in one season.
